BC Hydro currently serves power to the City of Kimberley Nordic Ski Club from an existing BC Hydro owned-maintained Low Profile Transformer (K329) located on DL 13800. The City of Kimberley would like a second service from this LPT to serve a new Nordic Ski Club Cabin (in plan stages; no foundation yet). This would involve running underground power cable in duct approximately 25 metres to the new Nordic Ski Cabin which is on DL 13801. (see attached proposed drawings Design 3466891)

The LPT is accessed by the road (North Star Drive) that serves the current City of Kimberley Nordic Ski Club site.

Construction is tentatively scheduled for the Spring of 2010 with completion by next years ski season (December 2010)
