Section A - Project Overview

The purpose of this project is to provide private moorage for one boat and personal recreational use on Skaha Lake in Kaleden, BC adjoining the property located at 227 Ponderosa Avenue.

Section B – Project Details

This project would provide approximately 43 m² of dock area for recreational use and moorage for one boat over three seasons of the year. The footprint of the proposed dock is a total of 30.48 m long and consists of a 28.04 m x 1.21 m finger followed by a 3.65 m x 2.43 m deck. Support will be provided by 13 pilings approximately 12 inches in diameter. There are no plans to add structures such as a boathouse or lift. No dredging or disturbance/removal of vegetation is required. During low water, most of the structure will be exposed. During high water, the pilings will be partially submerged but the dock surface will remain well above the high water mark. Materials used will include non-treated pilings and materials treated with approved preservatives such as ACQ and CA. There will be no treated wood below the high water mark. As much construction activity (cutting/sawing/drilling) as possible will take place on land well away from the shoreline to avoid contamination of the water with wood fragments, and installation of the pilings will be completed from a barge. Onsite work is anticipated to require approximately two weeks to complete, with a proposed start date in July 2011.

The distance of the proposed dock site from the property lines would be 5.1 meters to the north and 14.9 meters to the south. There is one dock to the south of the property, situated more than 30 meters away from this site. Public access to the beach will not be affected.
