Dear Mr. Comin,

This letter is in response to your conversation with Alan Minty, President of Heemskirk Canada, regarding a Quarry and Aggregate Permit for Rip Rap production at our mine. The Rip Rap produced are oversized pieces of silica rock that are a by-product of the operations that are carried out. This land is already tenured as a mining lease and operates under mine permit number M-181.

You had requested some additional information. One was the PDF of the mining plan which is attached. The other was a shape file, but since this mine has been in operation since the early nineteen eighties; the data for the mine (Tenure ML344488) is already in the Government of B.C. We do not have any scheduled rip rap sales; we expect only intermittent requests from local contractors. Therefore, we expect to sell less than 5,000 tonnes per year.
